Helping young artists and designers achieve the dream

Worldstudio Foundation in conjunction with AIGA, the professional association for design, provide scholarships to minority and economically disadvantaged students who are studying the design/ arts disciplines in colleges and universities in the United States. Among the Scholarship's primary aims are to increase diversity in the creative professions and to foster social and environmental responsibility in the artists, designers, and studios of tomorrow. To this end, scholarship recipients are selected not only for their ability and their need, but also for their demonstrated commitment to giving back to the larger community through their work.

Applications are evaluated by a jury of creative professionals appointed by Worldstudio Foundation and AIGA. In selecting the student awards, jurors take into account a number of factors, including: quality of submitted work, financial need, minority status, academic record, recommendations, and strength of written statement of purpose.

Since 1995, AIGA Worldstudio Scholarships has awarded over more than one million dollars to 700+ minority and economically disadvantaged college students of design, art, and architecture. Scholarships start at \$2,000 and reach \$5,000. In addition, honorable mention prizes in the amount of \$500 cash are awarded.

Each year, hundreds of students apply for these scholarships, and on average 15 to 25 ultimately receive awards. This is a testament to the strength of the winning entries, but also a reminder of the ever-growing need for funding from partners like you.

WAYS OF GIVING

The way you or your organization can support AIGA Worldstudio Scholarships can be tailored to suit your individual needs, your institution's philanthropic agenda, or your corporation's cause-related marketing initiatives. Programs are typically custom-tailored to suit goals and budgets, but following are some examples:

\$2,500 (minimum donation)

One scholarship awarded in a family name, or in the name of your corporation or institution.

\$5,000 – \$10,000

Two to four scholarships awarded in your name. Additional amounts can be given in increments of \$2,500.

\$25,000 +

At higher levels of giving, Worldstudio and AIGA can discuss with you options for custom-tailoring a program that includes mentorships and scholarships as well as promotional opportunities.
